**3. Operational Update**

**a. New Corruption Reports/Complaints**

The Commission received a copy of one new report which has been received by the Manager. The report was accepted as it gave rise to a reasonable suspicion on the part of the Commission that a criminal offence or an attempt to commit an offence or a conspiracy to commit an offence under the Anti-Corruption Law ("ACL") had been committed (see Sec 4 (1)(c) of the ACL).

It is noted that both Member Sophia Harris and Member Tim Ridley recused themselves from considering this new report due to professional and personal conflicts respectively.

The Commission was informed that since inception (1<sup>st</sup> Jan. 2010) there have been 163 reports registered by the Commission, of which:

- a. 7 are 'pending' awaiting further or sufficient information which may make it appropriate to make further investigations;
- b. 115 have been concluded;
- c. 16 have not met the threshold or fallen under the remit of the Commission;
- d. 10 have been transferred to other investigative units for action; and
- e. 15 are now under current active investigation.

**4. Action Items**

The Secretariat will provide members with a copy of those amendments agreed to be recommended to the CIG for inclusion in a future amendment to the ACL.
