2019/2020 Annual Report of the Anti-Corruption Commission

The Anti-Corruption Commission (“the Commission”) has submitted its [2019/2020 Annual Report](#) (“the Report”) as required in accordance with s.9(b) of the Anti-Corruption Law (2018 Revision) (“the Law”).

The annual report provides highlights on the efforts undertaken by the Commission during the 2019/2020 reporting period. The report also provides statistical information regarding arrests, interviews, searches, and more. Key topical issues mentioned include various policy matters, and public engagement initiatives which included meetings with the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service, and a presentation to the Cayman Islands Customs and Border Control and other stakeholder engagement endeavors.

This reporting period is also recognised as the end of tenure of Chairman Richard Coles, who has served the Anti-Corruption Commission diligently.
